## **Range Safety Rules**

- 1. All Firearms brought onto the range MUST be completely unloaded and carried in a gun case, box or with the action open until you have reached the shooting booth. All semi-automatic pistols shall be carried with the magazine out and the slide locked in the open position.
- 2. Only authorized firearms and ammunition may be used. Inspection will be required. No black powder.
- 3. Shooters renting guns must be accompanied with a partner. Those that bring their own firearms are exempt from this rule and may rent and shoot alone.
- 4. Use of ear and eye protection is required at all times while in the range. No exceptions.
- 5. Long guns are to be carried with the action open; safety on; barrel up.
- 6. The muzzle of all firearms will be pointed down range at all times.
- 7. Any person observed firing at anything other than a proper target will be instructed to leave the range immediately, and will be held liable for any damages incurred by such actions.
- 8. The use of alcoholic beverages and / or narcotic drugs are prohibited prior to or during shooting.
- 9. Open one (1) door at a time when entering or leaving the range.
- 10. No pregnant women allowed on the range even as spectators. **Prop 65.**
- 11. All persons under the age of 18 years old must be accompanied by a legal guardian. This adult shall act as a coach and must remain with the minor at all times while the minor is using the range. NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 10 ALLOWED IN FIRING RANGE.
- 12. Only one (1) shooter, or one (1) shooter and one (1) coach are allowed at each shooting position. Persons NOT shooting or coaching are not allowed on the range at any time.
- 13. Only line of sight shooting is permitted. No snap shooting, quick draw, fanning or hip shooting is permitted. Holsters are NOT allowed. No cross lane shooting allowed.

- 14. "Double Taps" are permitted. NO RAPID FIRE. Allow 3 seconds between shots.
- 15. Any injury sustained on the range, regardless of how minor it may seem, will be reported to the Range Master immediately.
- 16. While on range: NO Smoking, No Eating, No Drinking, And No Chew.
- 17. Dry firing is allowed only at the firing line.
- 18. If a misfire or malfunction occurs, keep firearm pointed downrange. Hold for 30 seconds, and then signal Range Master for assistance.
- 19. Report any accidental discharges and any damage which result from said discharge to the Range Master. Failure to do so will result in the revocation of range privileges.
- 20. Never move forward of the firing line for any reason. If firearm or any equipment falls forward of firing line, or if target falls from the hanger, notify the Range Master. Brass forward of the firing line may NOT be picked up.
- 21. Each time a firearm is picked up for any purpose, open the action and make an inspection to insure that it is unloaded and safe.
- 22.Do Not leave a loaded firearm unattended. Unattended firearms will have cylinders or \* actions open at all times when not being fired.
- 23. When finished at your shooting position, place your unloaded gun in its case, box or open the action. All semi –automatic pistols shall be carried with the magazine out and the slide locked in the open or rearward position. Report to the Range Master Station.,
- 24.**CEASE FIRE**: On this command, stop shooting immediately, lay gun down, step back from the firing line.
- 25. Rental guns must be used only with our ammo for insurance reasons. Damage to rental guns through carelessness will be the financial responsibility of the customer.
- 26. Only ammo under the velocity of 4,000 fps is permitted in the range.
